

## Permission to seek urgent medical, dental or hospital treatment

In the unlikely event that a child at the preschool is involved in a serious incident, injury, trauma or illness staff will follow the procedure outlined in the Incident, injury, trauma, illness, fever, minor ailments and first aid policy.

The Nominated Supervisor or “person responsible” for the preschool will ensure that:-

- A staff member remains with the child until the child recovers, a parent arrives or another responsible person takes charge.
- If the child requires medical or dental treatment that immediate steps are taken to secure that treatment.
- The child is returned to the care of the parent.
- Where medication, medical or dental treatment is obtained that the parents are notified as soon as practical, providing details of the accident, injury, treatment and the services arranged for the child.
- The Approved Provider is notified of the incident.
- Staff complete associated report forms and submit these as required.

**In order for staff to seek urgent medical, dental or hospital treatment** or call an ambulance and give permission for such professionals to carry out appropriate medical, dental or hospital treatment in the event that such action appears to be necessary due to injury or illness – **we require parents’ permission.**
